- Schools may enter **two** teams. The **OPEN VARSITY** team will be the **UOVHSAA qualifier** and count for points with the exception of SINGLES division. (See playing regulations). The **SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (HS)** team is **recreational** and is for grade 11 & 12 students only! Medals will be given for 1st and 2nd place in both divisions. **ALL PLAYERS MUST BE REGISTERED IN OFSAA HUB.**
- Only 2 entries per event, per school are permitted. (USE Entry Sheet provided). **Please note the EXCEPTION: If you have SENIOR players, we will add them to the SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL team, however, you must fill your “A” team first. See NOTE Below.**
- The tournament will be in the Double Elimination format. (Round Robin as per playing regulations)
- All matches will be played on 8 courts. We will leave one court for spectators to sit on the bleachers as well as on stage. **DO NOT SET UP YOUR SCHOOL OR LEAVE BACKPACKS ON THE TABLES IN THE CAFETERIA AREA.**
- **Yonex MAVIS 350** yellow shuttles will be used.
- Coaches ensure that all players wear school uniforms/colors or whites (**NO spandex volleyball shorts are permitted**). **COACHES MUST enforce proper dress code both on and off the court.** Ball caps are not to be worn during play but are allowed in our hallways. Electronic devices such as iPods, cell phones, etc. and ball caps are permitted on site.
- The Rally Point scoring system to 21 points will be used. (win by 2 to max of 30 points)
- All players **must** wear protective eye wear while on the court (**warm-up & game**). Players will not be permitted to play without it. **COACHES PLEASE ENSURE THIS!**
- Other details to be discussed at the coaches’ meeting at **8:15 a.m.** in the staff dining room. Coffee/juice and muffins for coaches will be provided there as well.
- **Should you need to make changes to players’ names (or indicate that a player is not coming), please inform my tournament workers at the scorer’s table before you attend the coaches meeting. Volunteers will be happy to make those changes for you on the draw sheets and on the score sheets if they have already been prepared. NO ADDITIONAL PLAYERS CAN BE ADDED AT THIS TIME UNLESS THERE HAS BEEN A SCRATCH.**
- Please remind your players that our tournament workers will fill out the score sheets (badminton chits) for them but they should ensure the score is correct before they leave the court.
- **For safety reasons, coaches are asked to prohibit players from playing badminton in the cafeteria and other areas of school.**
- As per RCDSB guidelines, masking is required when not in “ACTIVE PLAY.”
