

## FEES & OFFICIALS FORM

Each team is responsible for bringing volunteers to the meet in order for it to be run effectively. Instructions and a schedule will be given to these individuals at the officials meeting on race day.

### **VOLUNTEERS:**

- These individuals will be asked to assume one of the following roles (to be assigned by the race convenor):
  - Start Referee
    - Will be in the start area, ensuring that the start is run according to Alpine Canada guidelines for race safety (as outlined in the ICR)
    - Must be an adult with prior race experience (ideally holding level 2 officials certification).
  - Finish Referee
    - Will be in the finish area, ensuring that the race is run according to Alpine Canada guidelines for race safety (as outlined in the ICR)
    - Must be an adult with prior race experience (ideally holding level 2 officials certification).
  - Chief of Course
    - Will be on course all day, ensuring that race safety and course quality meets Alpine Canada guidelines (as outlined in the ICR)
    - Must be an adult with prior race experience (ideally holding level 2 officials certification).
  - Chief of Gates
    - Will be responsible for assigning gate judge duties
    - Must be an adult with prior race experience (ideally holding level 2 officials certification).
  - Starter
    - Will be at the starting gate to start the racers.
    - Must be an adult (could be parents, coaches or other adults associated with your team).
  - Assistant Starter
    - Will be at the start organizing racers by start order.
    - Recorder
      - Will sit in the timing hut and record race times.
      - Must be an adult (could be parents, coaches or other adults associated with your team).
  - Bib Collector
    - Will stand at the end of the race course and collect race bibs from the athletes after the second run.
    - Must be an adult (could be parents, coaches or other adults associated with your team).
