FOOD:	Food at golf course: hot dogs, sausages, sandwiches, & snack foods Kitchen will be open - if you are looking for a speciality platter.
PRACTICE ROUND:	Anytime after 3:00 (including weekends). You will need to make a tee time and inform the course you are participating in the high school tournament.
TEAMS:	BOYS: Two 4 player teams GIRLS: Two 4 player teams
TYPE OF EVENT:	18 Holes, stroke play event
EOSSAA QUALIFY:	UOVHSAA can qualify 2 Boys Teams, and 2 Girls Teams, plus 2 individual players, Girls and Boys, WHO ARE NOT on a qualifying team.
COACH/SUPERVISORS:	NO communication to players during event, by parents, coaches, supervisors, including cell phone contact. Coaches will be asked to help with activities during the day. Either walking with a group, or spotting on certain holes.
CADDIES:	Caddies are not allowed.
DRESS CODE:	Student players must wear appropriate golf clothes, no blue jeans, or shorts, cut-off shorts, tee-shirts, mock turtle necks are allowed.
PACE OF PLAY:	All coaches are asked to ensure that their players can maintain pace of play. The minimum expected standard is that their players can shoot 110 for 18 holes. As mentioned, emphasis will be placed on keeping play at an appropriate pace.
FIRST AID:	All schools are expected to bring a first aid kit. Also, students must be able to contact their coach in case of an emergency.
UOVHSAA:	Student eligibility, behaviour expectations, and sport safety guidelines are the responsibility of each school.
PLAYING RULES:	Playing rules will be sent to all schools before the event.
